Not only did Secretary Ross accompany Mr. Trump to the event, he was photographed signing Trump/Pence campaign signs and going around the room actively complaining. This event was promoted as a campaign rally (so they could legally limit attendees to just supporters). It was paid for with campaign funds. The Hatch Act of 1939 states hat, apart from he President and Vice President, no o her Executive Branch employee can use his or her position to campaign for a candidate. This means sitting cabinet members are forbidden from participating in campaign events of any type.  I am also lodging an official complaint against White House Deputy Press Secretary Sarah Huckabee Sanders, who may have violated the Hatch Act just by tweeting out a photo of Secretary Ross signing a campaign sign (link (https://twitter.com/SHSanders45/status/858523832331776000)), and by adding Trump's "MAGA" campaign slogan as a caption.  If you need a copy of the above twitter photo, let me know. I can upload it to you upon request.  This whole administration is nothing but a conflict of interest. From the Trump kids, to the phony trusts, to allowing them to sit on on official meetings with heads of state before they have security clearances. I am a retired IRS agent (37.5 yrs, auditing mostly corporations & exempt organizations, including political organizations and trusts). I was not even allowed to put a candidate's bumper sticker on my car because of the impression it might give a taxpayer about who or what I supported. The Hatch Act was drilled into us all the time, and it was clear there was zero tolerance. Believe it or not, I had no idea what political par ies my supervisors belonged to or supported. T
