What is a Live Course of Study?

A Course of Study is multi-part training series designed to help ethics officials develop comprehensive skills in an ethics program area. These programs are multi-week live trainings that concentrate on one topic or skill.

What will this summer's Live Course of Study cover?

OGE plans to conduct a live Course of Study on advice and counsel this summer. This will include opportunities for ethics officials to develop a foundation for providing advice and counsel and to complete some practice exercises. All live events will be recorded and published, along with all course materials, on a new Advice and Counsel Course of Study page in the IEG library.

Is this summer's Live Course of Study for me?

The Live Course of Study is designed for you if you are an early career ethics official interested in developing your ability to provide accurate and thorough advice and counsel.

Will this summer's Live Course of Study be eligible for PEP credits?

No. Successful completion of this program will entitle you to a certificate for this specific program.

If I am an ethics program leader, how can I use the Live Course of Study to train my staff?

This program will be a mix of live training sessions, supplemental videos, and individual assignments. Ethics colleagues and offices are encouraged to participate together.
