As a result of its review of the Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) ethics program, the Office of Government Ethics (OGE) issued one recommendation in its September 2018 review report. OGE recently conducted a follow-up review to assess whether DNFSB has taken sufficient action to resolve the deficiencies underlying the recommendation. The results of the follow-up review are summarized below.
